Intern Position Summary

This is an unpaid internship. Part-time shifts will be scheduled between Tuesday and Saturday.

Duties and Responsibilities

- **Marketing**
 - Brainstorm, draft, and execute social media campaigns
 - Provide social media reporting and suggested action items
 - Assist in creating a comprehensive social calendar
- **Events**
 - Promote Living Coast events through various channels including Facebook, news sites, local calendars, blog, etc.
 - Attend various events/programs on and offsite to gather photos and videos for future promotion
 - Assist in media coordination when needed
- **Content Creation:**
 - Capture and process high-quality photos & videos
 - Use digital software to create shareable graphics, videos, GIFs, and marketing materials
 - Categorize photo libraries
- **General**
 - In addition to these tasks, the position will have a marketing project which will be completed at the end of 12 weeks.
 - Other duties and tasks as assigned by supervisor.
